Class Descriptions:

Tumblebus

Tumblebus is a gym on wheels filled with fun equipment--bringing the best possible physical education class to children. We provide a fun way for children to receive the physical fitness that is so important to their development. Experienced instructors strive to make the experience memorable as well as educational. Our program builds self-esteem in children as they accomplish each physical skill in the lesson plan which changes weekly.

Math and Music Madness

Students will explore the many parallels in the worlds of music and math by learning about rhythm, patterns, division of time, intervals, transposing, negative and positive values (sound vs. silence), coordination, parallel movement vs. counterpoint, intensity, capacity (measures), velocity, addition, subtraction, division and multiplication and much more! Students will play percussion and other instruments.

Musical Theater

Learn to act, dance, and sing in this class that combines all three. Parents and friends are invited to attend an open class and performance on the final day of class.

Group Guitar

Students will learn basic to intermediate skills to start playing melodies and chords on the guitar. Music fundamentals are also covered as part of the curriculum to help the students better understand the concepts, the instrument and the music studied. Previous musical experience a plus, but not a requirement.

Violin

Students will learn the basic skills to start playing the violin as well as reading music. Students must have own instrument.

Rock Band

This hands-on program will teach students to play rock songs on their instrument of choice (guitar, keyboard, bass, percussion, and voice). Students get to experiment playing different instruments and learn a variety of rhythms and songs. The listening component of the program allows the students the opportunity to listen to different styles of music. No previous musical experience needed. Having own instrument a plus.

Yoga

The practice of yoga stimulates circulation, transforms stress, develops awareness coordination and whole-brain thinking. Yoga offers a fun, non-competitive physical challenge. Yoga poses are simple movements that integrate, soothe, and energize the body and mind. As Maria Montessori wrote, "The land is where the roots are, the children must be taught to feel and live in harmony with the Earth. Let the child explore the nature-- seeing more, feeling more, touching more." Yoga does this!

Chess

The purpose of the chess club is to teach students analytical and critical thinking skills. Under the tutelage of professional chess instructors, students will engage in activities to learn impulse control, pattern recognition, how to evaluate the consequences of a decision, sportsmanship, and much more. Intro to Photography

This class will cover the basics of photography from the parts of the camera to using the different settings and experimenting with different lighting, subjects, distance and composition. Having own digital camera a plus.

Intro to Arts and Crafts

Students will explore different materials to create works of art in this hands-on class. Some of the materials the students will use include: paint, paper mache, clay, play dough, beads, and more.

Beadwork and Jewelry Art.

Students will design and create their own pieces of jewelry such as necklaces, bracelets, earrings and pins using different types of materials, colors, textures and patterns. Our LEARN TO BEAD program uses a structured, skills-based, rather than an ad hoc project-based, approach to our curriculum. Attention is paid to what skills should be taught, and in what order, to create the most successful approach to learning beadwork and jewelry design.

Music Appreciation & Song Writing

Students will listen to and learn about different music styles through history and in the World. Students will also write their own compositions and lyrics while learning about rhyme patterns, rhythm, melody and harmony.
